Has anyone sampled the off-the-shelf spray paints to find the ones which best match old computer cases? I have tried Rustoleum Heirloom white and ivory bisque, both both are a bit too "bright". In one of the photos, I am showing my creamiest tower, but the heirloom white is too biscuit-coloured and bright, while the ivory bisque looks to be of a better match, but still quite a bit too "bright".

It is very difficult to accurately portray colours through the camera/monitor, but from what I tell, it seems that "computer beige" is an ivory colour with a hint of grey-green. Has anyone found a suitable off-the-shelf representation of this colour in a spray can? From the two I have tested, ivory bisque is the closer match, but not close enough. If you look at the second attached photo, you can see the actual case inbetween the ivory bisque and the heirloom white. This case is one of the brighter cases too; it is the 3rd case from the right of the first photo.



Yeah please let us know if there are any RAL codes on the cans.

Off the top of my mind I would have said RAL 1013 Oyster White seems to be a good pick for a case beige but I can't find any photos of people who used this color.

I've also seen some cases painted RAL 9003 Signal White and it seemed a bit too white at first but I would guess it's probably closer to how the cases looked when they first came out of their boxes. I actually have a NOS AT case and was kind of amazed at how white it is when I took it out.

RAL RAL 9016 Traffic White is also a good candidate.

Has anyone actually tried either of these colors before?

There is also that not all cases were the same hue, some are more white and some are more beige. If I were to wager a guess these cases came out of the factory looking mostly like RAL 9003 for the whiter specimens and RAL 9016 for the beige specimens.



Here's a little comparison I did for some RAL paint codes; I compared them to the three most commonly referred to spray paints on the market as well as the color of my Deskpro EN from my own photographs.

Long story short: Oyster WHite seems to be a good match for the older, really beige 80s to early 90s cases while Signal White seems to be a good match for whiter late 90s to 00s cases.


I was looking at Montana Gold sprays the other day as they are very very high quality and have great adherence to plastic even without primer, and I noticed two that are outstanding: Shock White Cream and Pebble.

And with that, I broke down the alternatives into two groups; one for the more almond-like (Y>5%) cases akin to the Amiga 500 and and one for the more white-like cases (Y>5%) akin to the Compaq OEMs and most cases from the Pentium era and onwards.

The file is attached below.

I feel like RAL1013 for those almond cases and RAL 9003 for the whiter cases are mostly spot on. It also happens to be that I actually have a can of RAL 1013 at home, and Iplaced an order for a RAL 9003, so I will spray them side by side onto cardboard and lay them on a couple of cases I have around, and post photos of the comparisons next week.




